Third COVID-19 screening clinic opens in Laval

The public health department stepping up its efforts in Laval area

Laval, May 21, 2020 – The public health department of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de Laval is increasing its testing capacity in Laval by opening a third clinic at the Saint-François Arena. Changes have been made to the opening hours of the screening clinics at the Cartier Arena and Pierre-Creamer Arena.

Groups prioritized for testing

- People with flu-like or COVID-19 symptoms (fever, onset or recent worsening of a cough, breathing difficulties, sudden loss of smell without nasal congestion with or without loss of taste).
- People who have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
