

People 70 years of age and older can receive their vaccine starting on Monday, March 1, 2021

Laval, March 1, 2021 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de Laval is continuing its COVID-19 vaccination effort with the immunization of Laval citizens aged 70 and over (born in and before 1951), in accordance with government directives. In anticipation of the mass vaccination, two new centres will be opened in the coming days to maximize the vaccination options.

For an appointment to receive the vaccine, visit [Québec.ca/vaccinCOVID](https://quebec.ca/vaccinCOVID). This is the fastest method. If you are unable to book your appointment online or if you are experiencing difficulties, ask a friend or family member for help or call 1 877 644-4545.

People in other age brackets will be vaccinated based on the priority groups established by the government and on the number of doses received by the CISSS de Laval. Visit [Québec.ca/vaccinCOVID](https://quebec.ca/vaccinCOVID) to follow the vaccination order planned in our region.

Reminder - Location of mass vaccination centres in Laval

To ensure accessibility for Laval residents, vaccination will take place in shopping centres. Those selected are as follows:

- In the west, the Méga Centre Notre-Dame, off Autoroute 13
- In the centre, Quartier Laval, near place Bell and Cégep Montmorency
- In the east, SmartCentres Laval Est, at the corner of Papineau Autoroute and the 440

Highlights of the mass vaccination

- Each mass vaccination centre will be able to vaccinate 800 to 1000 people per day, 7 days a week. They will be open 12 hours a day.
- Those wishing to get vaccinated will need to show identification and proof of residence in Laval.
- The vaccination will be carried out quickly, in a safe environment using a fully computerized and paperless process.
- The 5-step vaccination process will be as follows:
 1. Brief registration
 2. Evaluation and consent to vaccination
 3. Second verification to confirm the person's identity
 4. Administration of the vaccine
 5. Wait of 15 minutes or more to watch for the onset of any allergic reaction in the vaccinated person

Brief history of the vaccination campaign in Laval

Vaccination began on December 23, 2020 at Hôpital de la Cité-de-la-Santé with employees working in CHSLDs, intermediary resources and RPA. Then, in January 2021, the CISSS de Laval completed the vaccination of all users living in public CHSLDs.

Let's continue to protect ourselves!

It will take many months to immunize a sufficiently large number of people. In other words, vaccination does not mean the end of health measures.

We need to keep protecting ourselves by following physical distancing measures, wearing a mask or face covering and washing our hands often. Remember, too, that Laval is still a "red zone" and that we need to limit contact with others and comply with all instructions from public health authorities.
