Mass vaccination campaign against COVID-19

Laval, March 31, 2021 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de Laval would like to invite Laval residents 60 years of age and over to get vaccinated. Appointments are available at Quebec.ca/vaccinCOVID or by phone at 1 877 644-4545.

Location of mass vaccination centres in Laval

To ensure accessibility for Laval residents, vaccination will take place in shopping centres. Those selected are as follows:

- In the west, the Méga Centre Notre-Dame, off Autoroute 13
- In the centre, Quartier Laval, near place Bell and Cégep Montmorency
- In the east, SmartCentres Laval Est, at the corner of Papineau Autoroute and the 440

Let's continue to protect ourselves!
