

One Step Closer to Normalcy Laval moves to yellow zone

Laval, June 11, 2021 – Due to the improved epidemiological situation in Laval, the region will move to the [Level 2 – Early Warning \(yellow zone\)](#) starting on June 14, 2021 at 12:01 a.m.

Here are some of the [measures in force in yellow zones](#):

- Indoor gatherings in private homes including the occupants of two households will be permitted.
- Restaurants will open and occupants of two private residences can share the same table.
- Bars will be open under certain conditions.
- Outdoor activities for groups of up to 25 people will be allowed.
