

## Improved Epidemiological Situation Laval Moves to Green Zone

**Laval, June 25, 2021** – Due to the improved epidemiological situation in Laval, the region will move to the [Level 1 – Vigilance \(green zone\)](#) as of June 28, 2021 at 12:01 a.m.

Here are some of the [measures in force](#) in green zones:

- Indoor gatherings in private homes including the occupants of three households or a maximum of 10 people will be permitted.
- Restaurants and bars will open and occupants of three private residences can share the same table.
- Outdoor terraces can accommodate a maximum of 20 people per table.
- Outdoor activities for groups of up to 50 people will be allowed.

Although the alert level has changed, Laval's Director of Public Health, Dr. Jean-Pierre Trépanier, was careful to point out that, "The colour of the level is not as important as making sure everyone gets their second dose by the end of August, and their first dose as soon as possible, given the eight-week wait time between both doses. We will intensify our canvassing efforts in the Laval region to offer vaccination. Don't miss this important appointment, available in a public location near you!"

### Let's continue to protect ourselves!

As a reminder, the move to the green zone does not mean the end of health measures. The vaccination process must keep moving quickly so that a sufficiently large number of people are immunized. We need to keep protecting ourselves by following physical distancing measures, wearing a mask or face covering and washing our hands often.
