The Test Centres of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de Laval provide test services **by appointment** from Monday to Friday (except holidays). You must bring your prescription and your health insurance card to your appointment.

## Call for the tests below



You must make an appointment by calling 1-833-991-2662 if you need:

- a test for a child aged 6 and under
- a blood test during pregnancy
- a glucose tolerance test
- a semen analysis
- any test listed in the "Other specific tests" section of your requisition

## Distribution and return of containers (urine or stool)



### Blood test with urine analysis or stool culture:

- Make an appointment for your blood test.
- The containers and instructions will be provided to you during the appointment.

### Urine analysis or stool culture without a blood test:

- No appointment is required.
- Go to one of our test centres, ideally **before 11:30 a.m.**, to pick up the containers, receive the instructions, and return your specimens (samples).
- Do not take a ticket; please go directly to the reception desk of the test centre.

## Important information

When you arrive at the collection centre, please remember:

- to have your health insurance card with you;
- to bring your paper prescription, clearly labelled with your last and first name. It must also be correctly filled out, legible, and signed by your prescriber (physician, specialized nurse practitioner, etc.). Incomplete prescriptions will be refused;
- to follow any pre-appointment instructions given to you (do not eat or drink, no alcohol, etc.).
- to respect the time of your appointment and plan to arrive only 5 minutes in advance.
